What to Bring:

- Face Masks

- Diaper Cream (with a completed Medical Authorization Form)
- A nutritious lunch and snack in a lunchbox



Important Notes:

- Please label everything with the child's individual name (first and last initial).
- The arrival transition often sets the tone for both you and your child's day. It is important that all children arrive by 9 a.m. Please call or email if you think you may be late. Children will not be allowed to attend if they arrive after 9 a.m. without a doctor's note or prior arrangements made with the director.
- At Wesley, we're dedicated to promoting healthy eating and diets. Please send your child with balanced and nutritious food for their day! All food should be placed in your child's assigned lunch basket.
- Please keep personal toys at home.

What to Expect:

This nurturing environment provides a structured day which allows children to grow and learn while feeling safe and comfortable. Children are given opportunities daily to explore and learn through age-appropriate toys and projects. These teachers encourage children to use words to express their needs and wants. Children participate in activities developed to engender cognitive, linguistic, physical, and behavioral development. They will grow through their individual and group play activities.
